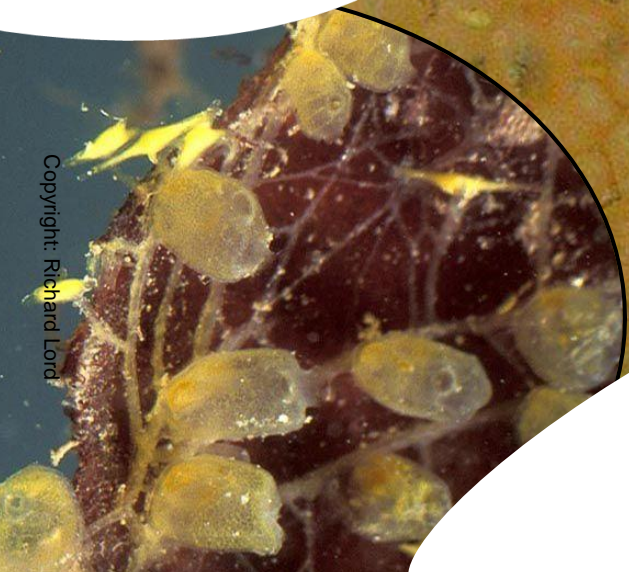


Colonial seasquirt

Perophora japonica

Originating from Asia, this seasquirt arrived in Europe attached to ship's hulls and in shellfish farms. For the moment it is only identified in some precise spots around the Channel.

Small translucent seasquirt of 0.2in (4mm) composing colonies of several individuals attached to algae, rocks, etc. The orange gut is visible inside. The stem connecting every individual together forms small yellow star-shaped plaques.
